AHUPUA'A

This summer our focus will be on the AHUPUA'A. The Ahupua'a land division that the Hawaiians used that ran from the mountain to the sea. Learning how each land area from mauka, kula, and makai provided resources for daily living and sustainability, and the importance of kuleana (responsibility), hana (work), and lōkahi (unity).

Kawaiaha'o Church School's Kula Kauwela/Summer Program is a great way to continue to give keiki exposure to 'ōlelo Hawai'i (Hawaiian language), teach keiki about Nā Mea Hawai'i, and to share Hawaiian culture and values. Keiki will be learning in an indoor-outdoor classroom environment.

Summer Session Dates:

This year, we are offering two Summer Sessions. You may choose to enroll your keiki in either one or both sessions.

Summer Session 1: **June 3 – 28, 2024**

Summer Session 2: **July 1 – 31, 2024**

Meals:

The school will provide a morning snack and afternoon snack. You may bring home lunch or order lunches through our catering service. If you are providing home lunch, please pack your child's lunch in a small cooler or insulated lunch bag. Catering service is available per session through *The Happy Bento*. Visit The Happy Bento website under Kawaiaha'o Church School to order. We encourage healthy eating habits and encourage proper nutrition from an early age. We do not allow candy or soda to be brought to school.

Drop-off and Pickup:

- Drop-off and pick-ups will be at your keiki’s classroom.
- Keikis should arrive between 7:00-8:00am (BSC 7:00-7:45am) in the morning and picked up by 2:30pm in the afternoon; pickup after 2:30pm will incur a late charge of \$1.00 per minute. We ask that all keiki arrive at school by 8am.

School Attire:

- KCS blue t-shirt to be worn daily
- Comfortable bottom wear (easily managed by your keiki, elastic waistbands work best!)
- Covered shoes or crocs worn daily (covered shoes required for huaka‘i)

Primary School Supply List:

(Please bring the following items on the first day of each session)

- 1 apron or large t-shirt
- 1 complete change of clothes & extra mask in a ziploc bag labeled with keiki’s name (to be kept in keiki’s cubby)
- 1 sleeping mat
- 1 fitted crib sheet for nap (taken home every Friday to be washed and returned on Monday)
- Covered shoes for walks
- ‘Ōmole wai/water bottle-bring your keiki’s ‘ōmole wai filled with water every day!

Other Summer Session Quick Facts:

- There will be one Huaka‘i/Field trip excursion per session; KCS t-shirt and shoes required for huaka‘i. Sunscreen should be applied before coming to school.
- We will require a signed health and safety policy at the start of summer session - so please check your keiki for signs of illness or fever over 99.9 degrees, if they are sick, we ask that you please keep them at home. If your keiki has a fever, they will need to be fever-free for 24 hrs. without the aid of fever reducing medication.
